No Expulsions: How to be Compliant with AB 752

On January 1, 2018, Assembly Bill 752 went into effect prohibiting unnecessary expulsions in CSPP classrooms and establishing a process for providers to address students' behavioral needs. Language was added to Title 22 that requires licensing analysts to consider the steps the center staff has taken to maintain a child's safe participation in the preschool program prior to determining whether or not to issue a citation and/or impose a civil penalty, in situations relating to children with serious and challenging behaviors.

Our Forum will provide you with practical information to develop and implement appropriate policies and practices so that your program can be compliant with licensing regulations, while also minimizing the need for expulsions. Sample behavioral support plans will be shared.
